SETTING

The Dead of Winter - Hatfield Peverel, England - 1556

SYNOPSIS

A tale of love, loss and suffering, The Wicked and The Damned tells the story of widow Agnes Windham and her teenage daughter, Joan.

With the collective anxiety about witchcraft growing within the walls of the small town Priory, local shepherd William Fynne grows suspicious of Joan and her relationship with his own teenage daughter, Margret.

As their relationship grows more intimate, Margret suddenly goes missing, with William outright pointing the finger at Joan, via means of witchcraft and conspiring with the Devil.

Agnes defends her daughter, pleading with William to keep his baseless claims to himself, as she fears Joan will be sentenced to hang by new local head of the Church, Rev. Thomas Cole.

However, as Joan's behaviour grows increasingly strange after Margret's disappearance, spending her nights talking to her newly found companion, a black cat named Sathan and suffering fever dreams of the 'Shadows in the Wood', Agnes begins to fear for her daughter's safety from both the Church and what lurks within the trees.

Director Statement

The Wicked and The Damned is an exploration into love, loss and suffering, set against the backdrop of the rising fear about witchcraft in Essex, England during the 16th century.

Born and raised in Essex, and currently residing in Chelmsford, Essex, the Essex witch trials have always been a period of history that has captivated me.

I have especially been fascinated by the idea of mass hysteria via religion, homophobia and misogyny; an idea that is as relevant today as it was back then, and one I plan to explore deeply in this film.

What sets The Wicked and The Damned apart from other witch trial-based pictures, is that we will explore how the growing fear of witchcraft impacts multiple characters and how that collective anxiety writes the fate of our characters in the eyes of faith, love and family.

While deeply routed in character, The Wicked and The Damned is first and foremost a horror film. I promise multiple horror elements throughout that will have the audience cowering in fear throughout, especially as they bear witness to our unholy trinity, the 'Shadows in the Wood', whom our main character Joan encounters during her night terrors.

Given that 60% of all supposed witches in England were accused and prosecuted in Essex, and also the fact that the Essex witch trials pre-date Salem by more than 100 years, I believe there is a story and legend to be told that will shock and absorb horror audiences around the globe.




Production and Distribution Timeline

- . 10-12 month to finish film from full funding lock
- . 6 month film festival run
- . 12 24 month full recoupment by Investor plus 20%
- . 24 month and beyond pure profit revenue split 50/50 between Investor and Producers

Recoupment

All proceeds of the Film paid to the Production Company from all sources after deductions of fees and expenses of the distributors, and from worldwide gross receipts for all media, in perpetuity, will be paid out as follows:

- . 100% to Investor until 100% of the total investment amount of the film is recouped
- . Plus, a further 20% of 100% investment amount
- . The balance will be considered "Adjusted Gross Receipts" and will be shared:
- . 50% "Adjusted Gross Receipts" to Investor and 50% to Producers


